



OPERATION: Andar HA Delivery



The Load Out: 8800 pounds of HA food items picked up in partnership with Marshal Plan Charities / Aschiana charity network in Kabul



The Build: Civil Affairs units palletize and net HA into sling loads preparing it for movement



The Slingload: HA is picked up for immediate movement to units at FOB Andar

Background:

Requests from the field in the Ghazni Province for prepackaged Humanitarian Assistance products resulted in a combined DOD and NGO effort. Marshal Plan Charities (MPC) (JoAnne Herring and LtGen (USAFR-Ret) and Mrs Bradley) and their NGO network partnered together to provide meals in a box. 144 boxes of goods were transported by air with the remainder following in a ground movement. Each box contains 36 meals and each meal feeds four people. In total, MPC provided 37,872 meals for distribution through Afghan Security Forces throughout the Ghazni Province.
